Discovering Nature Camp: ages 6-8

This outdoor day camp gets deep into exploring nature and the great outdoors while focusing on the senses, gardening, wildlife, exploration, and camping skills. Campers are asked to bring a sack lunch with them 4 of the 5 days, and to wear play clothes as they will be running, jumping, and exploring. For one day, kids will be cooking their own lunch in Dutch ovens. Please advise us of any allergies prior to camp. Additional information, including Dutch oven cooking day, will be e-mailed in a confirmation letter closer to the date of camp. Camp activities will be led by natural resource experts and licensed teachers.

Cost: \$100, 1 week session

Backyard Explorers Camp: Ages 4-5

Camp will focus on discovering the wonders of nature with activities led by natural resources experts and licensed teachers in an outdoor setting.

Activities could include seed planting, wildlife tracks, various education animals, and casting fishing poles along with many more fun and educational experiences.

Campers will receive a small snack each day, so please let us know about any allergies. More information and exact details will be e-mailed in a confirmation letter closer to camp.

Girls Adventure Camp: girls ages 9-14

This outdoor camp gives girls a chance to experience nature in a new way. It focuses on land, water, native flora/fauna, and skill exploration. Girls are asked to bring their lunch 2 of the 3 days of camp as the girls will try cooking their own lunch in Dutch ovens on one day. Enjoy archery, geocaching, and journaling. During the water exploration day, girls will have the opportunity to kayak, and fish. Please advise us of any allergies prior to camp. Additional information, including Dutch oven cooking day, will be e-mailed in a confirmation letter closer to the date of camp. Camp activities will be led by natural resource experts and licensed teachers.

9am - 3pm July 26 - 28, 2017

Boys Challenge Camp: boys ages 9-14

Get ready to sharpen your outdoor skills and be thoroughly immersed in nature in this outdoor camp. Enjoy water exploration, native flora/fauna, team building archery, and outdoor skills. Boys are asked to bring their lunch 2 of the 3 days of camp. One day, the boys will be cooking their own lunch in Dutch ovens. During the water exploration, boys will have the opportunity to kayak, and spend some time IN the water. Please advise us of any allergies prior to camp. Additional information will be e-mailed in a confirmation letter closer to the date of camp. Camp activities will be outdoors and led by natural resource experts and licensed teachers.

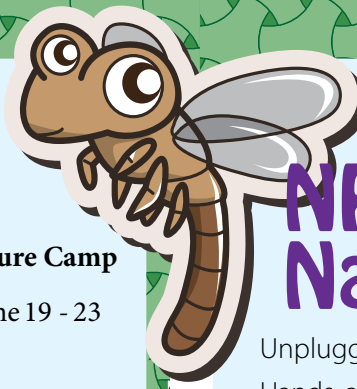
