## 1. <u>Review and Recommendation on 2018 Affirmative Action Policy – Tracy Thompson and Kelli</u> <u>Lieurance, Baird Holm LLP</u>

Tracy Thompson and Kelli Lieurance, Baird Holm LLP, briefed the Subcommittee on the District's Affirmative Action Policy for 2018 and all related actions that took place during Calendar Year 2017. Director Bradley inquired about veterans given preference when making hiring decisions. Staff member Jean Tait addressed his concerns.

## 2. <u>Review and Recommendation to Introduce Legislation in the 2019 Nebraska Legislative Session to</u> <u>Extend the Papio NRD's General Obligation Bonding Authority to the Year 2029 – John Winkler</u>

John Winkler briefed the Subcommittee on the status of the Papio-Missouri River NRD's General Obligation Bonding Authority (GOBA) that is to expire on December 31, 2019. By extending the bonding tool it will allow the Board of Directors the ability to continue to finance and construct vital capital-intensive projects when necessary. He reminded the Subcommittee that the extension authority does not call for a tax increase outside of the current statutory authority. There was discussion on the stipulations of using GOBA, the potential impact to the District's debt, and flood control projects that could be accomplished if GOBA is extended.

• It was moved by Director Fowler and seconded by Director J. Conley that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to immediately begin work within the legislative process to seek passage of legislation to extend the bonding authority past the sunset date of December 31, 2019.

Roll call was taken on the motion. The motion carried on a vote of 3-yea and 1-nay.
