WATERUSE REPORT/DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS:

Lance Olerich gave the water use report.

The water use report for water used during the month of March: 80.1% and the monthly average for 2018 is 82.8%. The City of Dakota City read their meters for March usage on March 15th, 2018.

The water use report for water used during the month of April: 67.5% and the monthly average for 2018 is 79.0%. April usage meters were read on April 27th, 2018. This is water charges from March 15th, to April 27th, 2018.

There are 22 customers on the June 12th, 2018 shut-off list.

The 16 customers on the April 10th, shut-off list and 25 customers on the May 8th shut-off list made payment or partial payment.

CONSIDERATION OF NEW HOOK-UPS AND TRANSFERS:
