1. <u>Review and Recommendation on Transfer of Funds from Construction to Land Rights for Zorinsky</u> <u>Water Quality Basin #2 – Amanda Grint:</u>

Project Manager Amanda Grint reminded the Directors that the Zorinsky Water Quality Basin #2 FY19 budget for construction cost is \$3,200,000, and that no dollars were budgeted for the land rights account. Amanda stated that while there was a last payment for a portion of the Zorinsky Water Quality Basin #2 land scheduled in FY19 that was inadvertently not placed in the budget, the construction budget will not be entirely used in FY19. Amanda went on to say that there are no changes proposed in what was anticipated to be spent on the land or construction but requested that \$468,736 be moved to the land rights account and that the construction account be decreased by that amount. Amanda answered Directors questions.

3. <u>Review and Recommendation on Land Rights for Missouri River Levee Certification Account</u> 01-03-560-4430 Over 110% – Paul Woodward:

Project Manager Paul Woodward reminded the Directors that the FY19 budget for land rights for the Missouri River Levee Certification Project was set at \$1,000,000. Paul stated that since the budget was set there have been revisions to the amount of land rights necessary as well as revisions to the appraised values. 13 of the 21 properties have closed for a total of \$1,040,817. The total to close the remaining 8 properties is approximately \$780,000 bringing the land rights acquisition cost to \$1,820,000. Paul answered Directors questions.

• It was moved by Director Conley and seconded by Director McCormick that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the amount for Missouri River Levee Certification Land Rights (01-03-560-4430) be allowed to exceed the budgeted amount up to \$1,820,000 without further approval by the Board.
