## 1. Review and Recommendation of Renewal of Government Relations Contract with Husch Blackwell LLP – John Winkler:

General Manger John Winkler briefed the Subcommittee on the proposed extension of the Government Relations contract for intergovernmental and professional lobbying services for the District. The current two-year contract with Husch Blackwell, LLP expires on June 30, 2019. The new contract would be for a period of two years, beginning July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021, at a new contract pay rate of \$7,000 per month for the first 12 months and \$7,500 for the second twelve months. There was discussion by the Directors to consider other firms and entertain the possibility of putting out a request for proposal for this service.

• It was moved by Director Japp and seconded by Director Fowler that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to execute a Request for Proposal for the provision of Government Relations services for FY 2021.
