GOVERNMENT RELATIONS CONTRACT WITH CATALYST PUBLIC AFFAIRS: General Manager Winkler briefed the subcommittee on the process undertaken to date to review and recommend a contract with Catalyst Public Affairs to provide Legislative Representation Services to the District. It was noted that the term of the contract was December 1, 2019 through

June 30, 2022 with a monthly fee of \$3,500 from December 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 and a monthly fee of $\$ 4,000$ for the months of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022. Director Gruenewald said he didn't care for the process of the contract approval through the Subcommittee.

- It was moved by Director Sopinski and seconded by Director Tesar that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed contract, for a period, from December 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022, with Catalyst Public Affairs, for the provision of intergovernmental and professional lobbying services per the terms and conditions outlined in the attached agreement as to form and with any changes deemed necessary by the General Manager.
