The District requested proposals for professional services necessary to design, permit and replace or rehabilitate District and City of Omaha Little Papillion Creek culverts and storm sewer outlets to meet US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) PL84-99 requirements. The Project consists of rehabilitating or replacing forty-seven deficient culverts/storm sewer outlets. Rehabilitation may consist of methods such as installing high density polyethylene (HDPE) slip liner pipes. USACE approval will be required for the culvert replacement or rehabilitation.
