The water use report for April was 86.9% with the monthly average 92.4%. the meter was read April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

The water use report for May was 101.6% with the monthly average 94.2%, the meter was read May  $28^{th}$ .

The water use report for June was 80.6% with the monthly average 92.0%, for 2020 and the meter was read June  $26^{th}$ .
