1. Review and Recommendation of Amendment No. 6 to Professional Services Contract with HDR Engineering for Zorinsky Basin 2 – Amanda Grint:

Project Manager Amanda Grint reviewed previous amendments to the Professional Services Contract with HDR Engineering, Inc. for ZB2, and stated that Amendment 6 would address extending the Project Management and SWPPP inspections, additional construction contract administration for up to 100 hours and survey channel cross sections to establish baseline for 404 permit reporting. HDR would provide these additional out of scope items on an hourly basis not to exceed the amount of \$43,991, for a total contract not to exceed amount of \$1,973,882. 2. Review and Recommendation of Amendment to Lower Platte River Consortium Interlocal Agreement – Paul Woodward:

Project Manager Paul Woodward presented the proposed Amendment to the Lower Platte River Consortium Interlocal Agreement between the Lower Platte South NRD, Lower Platte North NRD, City of Lincoln, Metropolitan Utilities District, Nebraska Department of Natural Resources and the District. The proposed Amendment would extend the duration of the agreement for one (1) additional year to September 27, 2021. Paul explained that the next steps in the continuation of the Consortium are to implement the Drought Contingency Plan and coordinate each year to review potential drought conditions. Paul answered Directors questions.
