WATER USE REPORT/DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS:

Lance Olerich gave the water use report.

Water use report for January 93.1% with the monthly average for 2023 was 93.1%. Dakota City read there meters on January 30th, and Dakota City read there meter on January 23rd, 2023. There were twelve customers on the January 16th, shut-off list.

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MANAGERS REPORT:

Lance Olerich gave the Manager's report. Lance and Bill have been performing regular maintenance for the month.

Water service line repaired on a 2" line along Hwy 35 on January 18th.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Bids on the Kramper Lake Water Main Extension Bids were opened on January 26th, at the Dakota County Service Center. Extension Project includes a new booster pump station, 75,000 gallon standpipe, and 15 miles of new water main.

Bid was accepted from Penro Construction Co., Inc. of Pender, Nebraska in the amount not to exceed \$3,094.108.31, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.

The Engineer's cost estimate, prepared by Olsson, is \$3,339,600. Funding for the project approved through the USDA Rural Utility Services includes a Water System Revenue Bond of \$1,954,000 and a USDA Rural Development Grant of \$1,762,000. The Dakoka County Rural Water Contribution is \$200,000.

Project complication date is October 31st, 2024.
