1. Construction Award for Golfing Green Drive Trail Connection – Eric Williams:

Project Manager Eric Williams presented the bid summary for construction of the Golfing Green Drive Trail Connection on the West Papio Trail from Giles Road near 108th Street to the corner of Harry Andersen Ave. and Q Street. Two bids were opened on June 27, 2023, and ranged from \$103,275.50 to \$116,519.00. The apparent low bid of \$103,275.50 was submitted by Ideal Construction Company, Inc. Eric reported that District staff worked with Felsburg Holt & Ullevig (FHU) for trail design, and Ehrhart Griffin & Associates (EGA) as a subconsultant, for additional services including bidding assistance. He stated that EGA reviewed the bid documents and provided a letter of recommendation to accept the bid from Ideal Construction Company, Inc. Eric answered Directors questions.

2. <u>Interlocal Agreement with City of Blair – WCRW #2 Supplementary Water Main</u> Connection Evaluation – Justin Novak:

Project Manager Justin Novak presented the proposed Interlocal Agreement with the City of Blair for the Washington County Rural Water #2 (WCRW#2) Supplementary Water Main Connection Evaluation which provides for a study of both water systems and a potential expansion project to serve additional customers in Washington County. He reported that HDR, Inc. was chosen as the consultant for the study since they currently provide hydraulic analysis and on call services for WCRW and the City of Blair. He indicated that HDR's total contract cost of \$64,800 will be split 50/50 between the District and the City of Blair. Justin reviewed the scope of work included in the study and answered Directors questions.
