1. Initial Screening of Proposals for Consultant Selection Interviews - Lori Laster:

Project Manager Lori Ann Laster briefed the Subcommittee on the Papio NRD Hazard Mitigation Plan Update. The plan must be updated every 5 years. The next update must be complete and approved by FEMA by June 2026. In order to apply for a planning grant through FEMA, the grant application must be completed this year. The District solicited proposals from qualified firms to prepare the grant application and update the plan. Only one proposal was received from JEO Consulting Group, Inc. The proposal from

JEO was discussed and the Subcommittee recommended staff be authorized to coordinate a professional service contract with JEO and to waive the interview process.

• It was moved by Director Japp and seconded by Director Bonnett that the Ad-Hoc Subcommittee recommends to the Board of Directors to waive the interview process under Director Policy 15.2 since only one engineering firm submitted a proposal in response to the advertised Request For Proposal and that the General Manager negotiate a contract with JEO Consulting Group, Inc. to provide professional services to update the District's Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP).
