B. PERSONNEL/MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:



Meeting Minutes July 27, 2023

The meeting began at 10:01 am.

- 1. Introductions
 - a. Lori Laster (Papio NRD) facilitated introductions.
- 2. Watershed Management Plan Update
 - a. Stakeholder Outreach
 - i. Molly Hanson (RDG) facilitated an exercise to determine the most important stakeholders to engage with early in the planning process. Stakeholder interviews are being scheduled for August and September. At the next Partnership meeting there will be some discussion of the key themes and concerns of various stakeholder groups.
 - ii. Developers, department directors, and elected officials were determined to be the groups to engage early.
 - b. Other updates: Houston continues to compile data necessary for updating the financial models for the plan. At this time there is nothing to report for the Partnership.
- 3. Website Updates
 - a. Lori Laster stated that part of the plan update is to overhaul the Partnership website (<u>https://papiopartnership.org/</u>) to make it a useful tool for both public outreach and Partner jurisdictions. The current website content hasn't been updated in quite some time.
 - b. The group discussed what the main focus areas should be. Residents of the watershed/general public and developers/contractors were the two groups that could benefit from the website.
 - c. Educational content for the general public could include things like a survey or other engagement tool so that we could know the locations of the people that are accessing the content. Part of the approved stormwater management plan for the PCWP is education and outreach. However, it's unclear if educational efforts are reaching people who live in the areas so it's important to at least know what jurisdictions are being reached.
 - d. Other content could include a guide to applying for a grading permit and what is required to obtain a permit. Many times staff at Partner jurisdictions



are required to walk people through the process step-by-step. A centralized resource would be helpful.

- 4. World O! Water Outreach Strategy
 - a. During NDEE reviews of the implementation of the approved stormwater management plan, it was noted that it is difficult to know if people attending outreach/education events lived within the jurisdiction of the PCWP communities. These public events draw people from many metroarea communities so it is unclear how much education is done within each jurisdiction.
 - b. The City of Omaha has created a survey that people will be able to take on their smart phone. This survey will then be tied to a map so that the approximate address of people who attend and participate can be shown for annual reporting.
 - c. Heaven Davis brought flyers for the event so that each community can advertise the event that will take place on September 9, 2023.
- 5. Other Items of Interest
 - a. The small MS4 permit is currently expired. Lori Laster will contact Patrick Ducey at NDEE to determine what the next steps will be in permit renewal.
 - b. The Partnership logo has been updated. These updates will be incorporated into the updates to the website and other outreach materials moving forward.
- 6. Next Meeting Date
 - a. The next regular meeting is scheduled August 24, 2023.
- 7. Adjourn
 - a. The meeting adjourned at 10:50 am.
