Sealed Bids for the construction of the Regional Detention Basin WP-2 will be received, by Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District (Papio NRD) at the office of the Papio NRD 8901 South 154th Street, Omaha, NE 68138 until 10:00 am local time on October 2, 2023, at which time the Bids received will be publically opened and read. The Project consists of constructing an earthen dam totaling over 100,000 cubic yards of earth fill with related rock riprap, reinforced concrete work, fisheries enhancement facilities, stream mitigation, and recreational features.
