#### 1. Bids for Silver Creek Watershed Dam Sites 30 & 33 Improvement Projects – Justin Novak:

Project Manager Justin Novak presented the bid summary for the Silver Creek Watershed Dam Sites 30 & 33 Improvement Projects, located near Tekamah, NE that consists of repairs to dam deficiencies found by the NeDNR during their annual dam inspection. Six (6) bids were opened on November 16, 2023, and ranged from \$144,100.50 to \$342,055.00. The Engineer's cost estimate prepared by Olsson was \$236,715.00. Olsson recommends that the apparent low bid of \$144,100.50 submitted by CDS Enterprise, LLC from Arlington, Nebraska be accepted. Justin and GM Winkler answered Directors questions.

#### 2. MoPac Trail Permanent Easement to Plains Sand and Gravel – Eric Williams:

Project Manager Eric Williams presented the proposed MoPac Trail Permanent Easement to Plains Sand and Gravel (Advantage Investment Properties, LLC) for vehicular and pedestrian ingress and egress due to their new mining operation east of Hwy 50, south of Springfield, NE, near the intersection with Cornish Road. He explained that the proposed access to the property would be an updated crossing over the MoPac Trail and answered Directors questions. Brian Buckingham from Plains Sand and Gravel was also in attendance to answer questions.

# 3. <u>Papillion Creek Watershed Agreement with Natural Resources Conservation Service – Amanda Grint:</u>

Assistant GM Amanda Grint presented the proposed Papillion Creek Watershed Supplemental Watershed Agreement No. 9 with NRCS which officially updates the 1967 PL-566 Work Plan for the Papio Watershed. She explained that the agreement allows the District to move forward with federal funding to complete six remaining grade stabilization structures and one flood control structure in the Work Plan. She indicated that the plan update, environmental assessment, and agreement will be placed on public notice for 30 days and answered Directors questions.
