Brent Meyer, Husch Blackwell, stated this hearing is being conducted in compliance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-2504. At this hearing, the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District will explain the nature and necessity of the Papio Dam Site 12 Project, and the reason for selecting this particular location. Each owner of property to be acquired by the District has the right to be represented by an attorney and to negotiate and accept or reject the offer made by the District for the proposed acquisition. The proposed land acquisition is from a willing seller, however, he or she has the right to require that such damages be determined pursuant to the procedures for acquisition by eminent domain. At this hearing, the District will hear and consider any objections from any person. Hearing Officer Winkler opened the floor to the public. No one from the public came forward to offer testimony.

Hearing Officer Winkler closed the Public Hearing at 4:10 p.m. and returned the floor to Chairman Sopinski.
