#### 1. <u>Contract Amendment with UNL for the Know Your Well Program – Amanda Grint:</u>

Assistant General Manager Amanda Grint briefed the Directors on the history of the Know Your Well Program and the NRD's role as Program Administrator for UNL and UNK. She stated that UNK wishes to terminate the agreement with the NRD, and they worked with UNL to transfer their Program Coordinator's employment to UNL. Amanda provided the Directors with a chart showing the proposed cost transfer from the UNK agreement to UNL agreement and stated that there is no change to the overall project budget, just a change in the distribution of funds. Amanda answered Directors questions.

### 2. <u>Contract Amendment No. 2 with EGA for the Beltline Trail Project – Eric Williams:</u>

Project Manager Eric Williams briefed the Directors on the Beltline Trail Project and the District's contract with EGA to develop a conceptual plan and to identify multiple phases of the project to be constructed independently. Eric reviewed phase 4 of the project and stated that the proposed Amendment #2 includes adjustments for services, updates to the scope and fee to complete design work on Phase 3, as well as newly included scope and fee for construction on Phase 3 and design and construction management for Phase 4. Eric answered Directors questions.

• It was moved by Director Thompson and seconded by Director Bonnett that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed Amendment No. 2 to the Professional Services Agreement between the District and Ehrhart Griffin & Associates for the Beltline Trail Project for the maximum amount of \$208,998.54 bringing the total maximum not to exceed contract amount to \$847,764.54, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.
