1. <u>Amendment to the Second Amended Agreement for the Lower Platte River Phragmites</u> <u>Management Program – Amanda Grint:</u>

Assistant General Manager Amanda Grint briefed the Directors on the history of the District's Interlocal Agreement with LPSNRD and LPNNRD to fund the Lower Platter River Phragmites Management Project. She stated that the amended agreement includes the use of drones for aerial spraying. Amanda answered Directors questions.

• It was moved by Director Thompson and seconded by Director Fowler that the Subcommittee recommend to the full Board that the General Manager be authorized to execute the Amended Interlocal Agreement with Lower Platte South NRD and Lower Platte North NRD for the Lower Platte River Phragmite Management Program. The District will keep a

selected qualified bidders list to have competitive bids and qualified bidders ready for the Program, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.

2. <u>Contract Amendment No. 5 with Schemmer for Platte River Bridge – Eric Williams:</u>

Project Manager Eric Williams reviewed the District's role as the lead agency in an Interlocal Agreement to design and construct the Platte River Bridge Trail Project. Eric stated that plans were completed, and bids accepted in the Fall of 2023. Hawkins was selected as the construction contractor. During the initial stages of construction reviews showed that work was needed that was not included in the original design contract with Schemmer. Eric told the Directors that a CWO has been approved by NDOT and documents to amend the original contract with Schemmer are being prepared. Eric answered Directors questions.

• It was moved by Director Fowler and seconded by Director Thompson that the Subcommittee recommend that the Board of Directors adopt the Resolution provided by NDOT authorizing the General Manager to execute a Supplemental, Agreement between the District and Schemmer & Associates for the Platte River Bridge Trail project, with total cost not to exceed \$19,562.55, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.

3. <u>Elkhorn River Trail Bridge Agreements – Eric Williams:</u>

Project Manager Eric Williams reminded the Directors that in October 2023 the District entered into an agreement with NDOT for the Elkhorn River Trail Bridge project following Board approval. Eric stated that the District has worked with NDOT on the scope and fee for professional services agreements on preliminary engineering and environmental service work. He said that following the completion of these tasks, amendments to the professional services agreements will be made to include scope and fee for the remainder of the design work to prepare the project for bidding and construction. Eric answered Directors questions.

a. <u>Professional Services Agreement with Schemmer for Design:</u>

• It was moved by Director Tesar and seconded by Director Fowler that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to waive District Policy 15.2 Purchasing – Professional Services and execute the proposed Preliminary Engineering Services Agreement with Schemmer & Associates for the Elkhorn River Trail Bridge project, with cost not to exceed \$99,208.70, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.
