A. INFORMATION/EDUCATION HIGHLIGHTS:

Lori Laster and Austen Hill participated in the "Introduce a Girl to Engineering" camp led by Omaha Public Schools. The event served as an opportunity for over 250 middle and high school girls interested in STEM-related careers to explore the field of engineering and engage with professionals in the field. It also enabled students to learn more about Papio NRD projects and responsibilities, with the hope of inspiring the next generation of natural resource managers.

B. PERSONNEL/MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- 1. The District has been awarded the Nebraska's Safest Company Award from the National Safety Council for the 15th year. Our culture of safety would not be possible without the great work of Nicole Gust, coordinator our Health, Safety and Wellness Committee, members of the committee, staff, and Directors. My deepest thanks to all! The award luncheon will take place on May 1 and the award letter is attached.
- 2. Construction on the Platte River Bridge Trail began in February and will continue throughout the summer. One of the northbound lanes of traffic is closed on the Hwy 34/75 bridge while major structural work has been in process. Work completed so far includes driving piles to support the abutments, an initial concrete deck pour, and placement of the girders connecting from the bridge to the land on both sides of the river. The project is expected to be complete by fall of 2024.

- 3. Interlocal Agreement Presentation
 - Ian Ghanavati stepped through the Interlocal Agreement presentation to be brought to respective Councils and Boards. The presentation is available to all Partners.
 - Ian Ghanavati offered to be present at any council or board meetings.
- 4. Stormwater Inspections Contract
 - The Partnership discussed the current Stormwater Inspections Contract with JEO, which runs through January 2025.



- The purpose of the Stormwater Inspections were discussed.
- The Partnership determined that they were satisfied with the work JEO had completed thus far and would consider the contract in the coming months.
 - A shorter future contract (1-3 years) was discussed due to the unknown pace of development once sewer construction begins in South Sarpy.

5. Other Items

- The Partners discussed the particulars of incorporating the SSWP Policies into their respective ordinances/resolutions. A future meeting will have further discussion on this topic.
- The Partners discussed the area where fees are collected, which is within the Watershed Management Area.
