1. Oakleaf Grade Stabilization Project Interviews – Ian Ghanavati:

Project Manager Ian Ghanavati briefed the Subcommittee on the Oakleaf Grade Stabilization Project. The Board solicited proposals from qualified firms to provide professional engineering services necessary to design and permit a series of grade control structures within the Oakleaf Subdivision, located southeast of South 72nd Street and Capehart Road. This project was identified in the Southern Sarpy Watersheds

Partnership in their 2024 Watershed Management Plan. Eight (8) proposals for professional services were received from consultants. The firms submitting proposals were Benesch, E&A Consulting Group, Embris Group, HDR, Houston Engineering, JEO Consulting Group, Snyder & Associates, and The Flatwater Group.

There was director discussion on their thoughts of the firms qualifications. Project Manager Ian Ghanavati stated that all firms that submitted RFPs were qualified to do the work required. Director Irvine asked when the 404 permitting occurs. Ian stated that the permitting happens after the engineering firm has been selected.

• It was moved by Director Thompson that the Subcommittee request interviews with Benesch, E&A Consulting Group, and Embris Group in the order present, on May 1, 2025, at 4:00 p.m.

Motion failed for a lack of a second.

Subcommittee Chairman Davidson asked each of the committee members to submit their top three firms (in no ranking order) to determine which firms would be selected to move on to the discussion of interview selection. Benesch, Embris Group, HDR, and JEO Consulting Group were the firms named to move forward for interview selection.

Director Fowler stated that the District does not normally receive eight proposals, and that it was in the best interest of the District to interview the four firms named during the Chairman's request of the top firm selection process.
