

RE: Contract Amendment #1 with HDR for Washington County Rural Water System Expansion Design

The Washington County Rural Water Expansion Project is a joint effort between the District and the City of Blair, with HDR being the engineering firm for both water system designs. There will be a new water tower, new water mains to reach 250 existing homes and increase capacities for all of Washington County Rural Water system allowing for more developments.

The original contract approved by the Board in October 2024 was for \$86,700 and is for the final design, permitting, funding applications and bidding services required for the expansion of WCRW #2. The Contract Amendment #1 is for additional services that were requested and not in the original scope of the contract to include public outreach for an additional \$10,900, bringing the total contract cost to \$97,600. The Objective in Amendment #1 is to notify all property owners within the new project limits of the proposed expansion, hold a public meeting to present the project and answer questions, and to solicit commitments for connecting to the proposed rural water system.

Management recommends that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement between the District and HDR for the Washington County Rural Water System Expansion Design for a maximum amount of \$10,900 bringing the total not to exceed contract amount to \$97,600, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.

PART 1.0 PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

ENGINEER is proceeding with the final design of the Washington County Rural Water System Expansion (PROJECT). OWNER has requested assistance to complete the public outreach to potential customers.

PART 2.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY ENGINEER ON THE PROJECT:

Items of Work

Public outreach for customer signup.

Key Understandings

- 1. All travel will be in proximity to the city of Blair, Nebraska.
- 2. The limits of the expansion and system modifications will be based on the PMRNRD WCRWS and Blair Connection Evaluation prepared by HDR dated April 5, 2024.
- 3. OWNER will provide the connection fee information for the owner interest survey for service.
- 4. OWNER will participate in the public meeting presenting the project.
- 5. OWNER will pay the rental fees for the public meeting facilities.

- Provide the drafts to the OWNER for review.
- Incorporate the review comments.
- Send up to 280 postcards to the identified landowners at least three weeks prior to the public meeting.

 Submit the ad request to the Washington County Pilot-Tribune and Enterprise for publication at least 14 days prior to the public meeting.

530 - Public Meeting

- · Identify the public meeting location and schedule the meeting.
- Prepare two display boards identifying the project limits, schedule, and FAQs.
- Prepare and print up to 150 copies of one informational handout, single sided.
- Set up for the meeting including meeting plan, name badges, sign in sheets, and 150 comment forms.
- Two HDR personnel will attend the meeting and complete the meeting set up and teardown after the meeting.
- Provide a summary of the meeting.

PART 3.0 AUTHORIZATION

OWNER will provide written authorization for the work. Work will not proceed without authorization.
