2. <u>Interlocal Agreement with Nebraska Game & Parks for Operation & Maintenance of the Danish Alps State Recreation Area Project – Terry Schumacher and Jim Swenson, Nebraska Game & Parks:</u>

Staff member Terry Schumacher and Jim Swenson, Nebraska Game & Parks, discussed the proposed agreement for the management, operation and maintenance of the Danish Alps State Recreation Area Project and the Cost Share Agreement between the District and the Nebraska Game & Parks Commission. The Recreation Area is expected to open to the public in the summer of 2015. The proposed agreement is to commence in 2015 and continue for a five year period. The Directors discussed the layout and features of the recreation plan along with the operating and maintenance budget.
