<u>Update on 2013 Market Analysis of District Job Descriptions – Jean Tait and</u> <u>Virginia Collins – SilverStone Group:</u>

The results reflect a need to make changes to increase the Pay Grade Midpoints. The impact of the increase will be 0.5% for the majority of employees.
