Notice of Proposed Acquisition and Notice of Public Hearing

ELKHORN RIVER - 240th STREET BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT (Sarpy County, Nebraska)

Please take notice that on November 13, 2014 at 7:00 P.M., the Board of Directors of the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District (hereinafter referred to as "the District") will hold a public hearing on the Elkhorn River - 240th Street Bank Stabilization Project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), which is generally located along the Elkhorn River southwest of 240th Street and Harrison Street, Sarpy County, Nebraska, and on the acquisition of real property for the project. Such hearing will be held at the principal offices of the District at 8901 South 154th Street, Omaha, Nebraska 68138-3621.

At the hearing, the District shall explain the nature and necessity for the project, the reasons for selecting the particular location, and the right of each owner of property to be represented by an attorney and to negotiate and accept or reject the offer of damages which will be sustained by the proposed acquisition, and the right to require that such damages be determined pursuant to the procedures for acquisition by eminent domain. The District shall hear and consider any objections from any person.

For purposes of the Project, the District proposes to acquire easements on certain real estate in Section 16, Township 14 North, Range 10 East of the 6th P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska, which you may own or in which you may have an interest (such real estate hereinafter being referred to collectively as "the Property").

1. The compensation to be given for the Property:

The compensation to be given for the Property will be the damages sustained by the respective owner thereof, as appraised by licensed real estate appraisers, generally consisting of the fair market value of the Property acquired plus any difference between the fair market value of the owner's remainder before and after the acquisition.

2. The authority for the acquisition:

The District's authority for the proposed acquisitions is contained in Neb. Rev. Stat. § 2-3229.

3. The nature of, necessity, and purpose for which the Property shall be used:

The Property proposed to be acquired will be used for the construction, operation and maintenance of a bank stabilization project along the Elkhorn River to prevent a portion of 240th Street from being threatened and/or lost to foreseeable and continued Elkhorn River Bank Erosion.

4. The right, title, or interest in the property to be acquired:

The District proposes to acquire permanent and temporary easements in, on, over and across lands required for the Project.

5. The amount of property needed:

The Property needed consists of the lands depicted in the parcel map attached to this notice and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

6. The reasons for selecting the proposed location:

The project is generally located along the western bank of Elkhorn River southwest of 240th Street and Harrison Street, Sarpy County, Nebraska. This location was selected due to the instability of a bend in the Elkhorn River in this area and to prevent damage to public infrastructure.

7. Approval required from other agencies:

No approvals from other agencies are required for the Project.
