1. Review and Recommendation on Nebraska Beekeeping Industry and Colony Collapse Disorder – Director Patrick Bonnett:

Director Patrick Leahy noted to the Subcommittee that recent information from NRCS on the Beekeeping Industry and Colony Collapse Disorder had prompted himself and Director Patrick Bonnett to see where the District could be involved. He noted that a meeting was facilitated with General Manager Winkler and the Omaha Bee Keeping Club to see if there were ways to work together. GM Winkler addressed the

Subcommittee and noted that the District currently has several bee colonies at Chalco and has a bee education component in our Information & Education department.
