## Review and Recommendation on Big Papio Levee Project (36<sup>th</sup> to Cornhusker Road) City of Bellevue Request for Permanent Easement for WATER WISE Demonstration Best Management Project:

Martin Cleveland stated that the City of Bellevue received grant funding for a WATER WISE bioretention garden demonstration project. As required by the grant, the City must include a public education component in the project. The City would like to construct the bioretention garden on District-owned property located just west of 36<sup>th</sup> Street, north of Highway 370, adjacent to the Big Papio Trail. Bellevue will be responsible for construction and continued maintenance of the project. The City is requesting an easement from the District for the project.

Mike Francis, City of Bellevue Parks Superintendent addressed the Subcommittee.

There was discussion.

It was moved by Director John Conley and seconded by Director Woodle that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed permanent easement to the City of Bellevue for their WATER WISE Demonstration Best Management Project, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.
