Re: P-MRNRD Regional Multi-Hazards Mitigation Plan - Grant Application to Nebraska

**Emergency Management Agency** 

In September 2006, the District worked with the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA), U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Nebraska Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and local emergency management agencies to provide a Regional Multi-Hazards Mitigation Plan (HMP) for the entire District. This plan benefits the District and local communities by providing a list of potential hazard mitigation alternatives, and also by increasing the potential of federal mitigation funding assistance for projects such as the District's Floodway Purchase Program. Federal funding through FEMA's Pre Disaster Mitigation Program is available to prepare and update Hazard Mitigation Plans. In 2011, an update of the 2006 plan was completed.

The HMP plan is required by FEMA to be updated every five years. The new update can be done at any time but needs to be completed by July 2016. It is anticipated that the plan update will take one year. A revised plan would not only meet our requirement to update within five years but would also:

- Make the plan compliant with FEMA's new Community Rating System manual. The Community Rating System provides discounts on flood insurance premiums for communities who use higher than FEMA minimum standards for floodplain management.
- Include communities not currently in the District's plan.
- Add information for communities already in the plan where data gaps occurred.

The estimated project cost is \$150,000 of which this grant would provide \$112,500 and District would be responsible for \$37,500. The proposed grant application is attached.

An engineering consultant will need to be retained to prepare the plan update. A timely approval of the grant application is anticipated, therefore, it is also recommended that the Chair appoint an Ad-Hoc Hazard Mitigation Plan Consultant Selection Subcommittee at the June Board meeting.

Management recommends that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed Planning Grant Application in the amount of \$150,000 for preparation of an updated Regional Multi-Hazards Mitigation Plan for the District, and that an Ad-Hoc Hazard Mitigation Plan Consultant Selection Subcommittee be appointed.

The current Hazard Mitigation Plan for the state of Nebraska was approved by FEMA on 05-19-2014. The plan provides a comprehensive set of guidelines for hazard response and mitigation in the state by identifying potential risks and vulnerabilities as well as appropriate mitigation measures to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to human life, property, and environment, and promote public awareness of hazards and potential hazard mitigation actions. The plan emphasizes the need for state, tribal, and local entities to closely coordinate mitigation planning and implementation efforts. The state believes that this approach is more feasible with capabilitybased goals rather than hazard specific goals. The primary objective of this planning initiative is to update the current Papio-Missouri River NRD Mitigation Plan, originally approved by FEMA on 8-10-11. The planning update will occur in six (6) tasks. Task 1: Kick-off Meeting, Project Management, and Quality Control. Task 2: Public Involvement and Stakeholder Participation. Task 3: Background Information, Data Collection, and Risk Assessment. Task 4: Develop Mitigation Plan. Task 5: CRS Credits for Participating Communities Task 6: NEMA and FEMA Review and Approval. The above scope will result in a state and FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Plan. Upon approval by NEMA and FEMA, color copies of the Hazard Mitigation Plan will be distributed to participating jurisdictions along with one CD containing an electronic version of the Plan in Microsoft Word and PDF format. The plan development process will be completed through cooperation and effort from Papio-Missouri River NRD, county and local governments, public and private schools, Nebraska Department of Natural Resources, NEMA, consulting services, and local stakeholders.
