**Re**: Papio Dam Site 15A Tract 12 Building Disposal

Dam Site 15A Project Tract 12 was acquired by the District in February 2014. This tract was the only improved tract acquired for the project.

There are currently six buildings sitting on the site (see attached map). There is also approximately 1,700 feet of decorative white vinyl fencing and 2,500 feet of corral fencing. At the October 9, 2014 Board of Directors Meeting, District Staff was directed to sell the buildings in a sealed bidding process.

On December 3, 2014 bids were opened. The highest and best bids for each asset are summarized below.
