The following proposed amendments are changes to the current Papio Missouri River NRD Recreation Area Rules and Regulations. The following changes were realized after the new recreation areas were opened on the Platte River and following the re-opening of the Elkhorn Crossing Recreation Area.

The intent of the proposed amendments to the current rules and regulations is to foster a clean, safe and secure environment in the District's Parks and Recreation Areas. To assist in eliminating graffiti, destruction of property, illegal activity and to enhance a family friendly environment in which constituents of all ages can enjoy our natural resources.

These Rules and Regulations will be forwarded to all Law Enforcement agencies within the District's boundaries for enforcement by certified officers of each department.

- > It is the recommendation of management that the Subcommittee recommend to the full Board of Directors that the revised Rules and Regulations for All District Recreation Areas be adopted, as presented.
- It is the recommendation of management that the Subcommittee recommend to the full Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to seek an Attorney General's Opinion on the legality of the District entering into an Interlocal Agreement with a certified law enforcement agency to provide additional security at the District's Recreation Areas and Facilities. Upon receipt of the A.G.'s opinion and if needed, the General Manager be authorized to seek enabling legislation in the 2010 legislative session in order to modify current state statute to allow the District to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with a certified law enforcement agency to provide added security at the District's Recreation Areas.
