
#### **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Lakeland Connection Project is to provide a safe, clean and dependable water supply to more than five hundred households in Washington County, Nebraska.


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






- \* The PMRNRD has been working with Lakeland Estates Water Company (LEWC) to evaluate extending a Washington County Rural Water Main to serve the community with a single hookup to their current water system
- \* Reasons for the project:
  - \* Replace Lakeland's wells that are high in iron, with a single rural water connection
  - \* Provide higher quality water to 525+ households
  - \* Provide a more dependable water source
  - \* Provide rural water along the Hwy 133 Corridor














