<u>MISSOURI RIVER TRAIL – PHASE 2 RESOLUTION</u>: Jim Becic noted that the District received correspondence from the Nebraska Department of Roads following the regularly schedule December 9th Board meeting indicating that the Board needs to take action on the resolution provided by the NDOR by December 29, 2010, to comply with laws concerning award or rejection of the project.

•• MOTION NO. 3

It was moved by Director Fred Conley and seconded by Director Erickson that the Board of Directors adopt the resolution provided by the Nebraska Department of Roads for the construction of a Federal Aid Project – the Missouri River Trail – Phase 2. Copies of the resolution were distributed at the special meeting and a copy thereof is attached to and incorporated in the file copy of the minutes of this special meeting.

Mr. Becic then answered several questions. He noted that 80% of the cost of the project will be paid by federal funds and that such funds for the federal cost share of the project have been received by the Department of Roads. He also noted that construction is scheduled to begin in April, 2011.
