WEST BRANCH CHANNEL PROJECT (2ND STREET TO GILES ROAD) RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION - TRACT # 5 (DONALD C. DITTUS) AND TRACT #24 (FREDERICK):

Chuck Dittus spoke to the Subcommittee regarding his property in Tract 5. He had four items he addressed:

1. The 3.6 acres located in the West Branch Papillion Creek should be worth \$550.00 per acre not \$100.00 per acre.

- 2. The 1.09 acres north of the creek should be raised from the appraised value of \$22,000.00 to \$37,500.00.
- 3. The 3.73 acres south of the creek should be worth \$20,000 per acre.
