WASHINGTON COUNTY RURAL WATER PROJECT #2: Sklenar gave a brief summary of the proposed rural water project, and of progress made to date. He noted that the District staff had negotiated a professional services contract with HGM Associates, Inc to design and inspect the project. The "not-to-exceed" amount of the contract was \$349,843.12.

• It was moved by Jansen, seconded by Tesar, that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to execute a professional services contract with HGM Associates, Inc. for the Washington County Rural Water Project #2 for a maximum fee of \$349,843.12, subject to execution of the Interlocal Agreement between the District, the City of Blair and Washington County, changes deemed necessary by the General Manager, and approval as to form by the District Legal Counsel.

OPPD PROPOSED CO-OCCUPATION AGREEMENT ALONG THE LITTLE PAPIO CREEK AND THE KEYSTONE TRAIL

Cleveland noted that OPPD had requested that the agreement be tabled for another 30 days to allow time for the final terms of the agreement could be resolved. He noted that the District's concerns were in three areas; responsibility for damages to the trail, criteria for future relocations, and indemnification.

Management recommended that the issue be tabled until February 12, 2004.

The Chair ruled that since the original tabling action was taken by the Board on December 11, 2003, the motion to table needed to be made at the Board meeting on January 8, 2004. Therefore, no action was taken.
