**P-MRNRD FY 2006 AUDIT:** Jack Lawless, District Accountant, introduced Jerry Bland and Hilary Allen, Bland and Associates, who presented the audit to the Subcommittee. Director Patterson asked if expense accounts were reviewed. Jerry Bland indicated that the expense accounts were reviewed in a random sampling. Director Patterson asked if payroll and retirement accounts were reviewed. Jerry Bland stated that individual payroll and retirement accounts were reviewed wholly.

A. Lyman-Richey Request for a Quit Claim Deed (Fairview Road to Capehart Road): Martin Cleveland gave a brief background of how the deed covers part of the easement area and as such is not needed. Director Connealy asked if the land would be placed back on the tax rolls. Martin indicated that it would be.

> ✤ It was moved by Director John Conley and seconded by Director Tesar that the FEL subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to negotiate and execute a Quit Claim Deed for SEC Accommodator LXV, LLC for a 16.5 ft. wide strip of property in SE1/4 of Section 9, T13N, R10E, Sarpy County, Nebraska, subject to approval as to form by District legal counsel.

Director Connealy asked if mining the area would enhance drainage. Martin stated that the lake would provide an outlet for drainage. Director Conley asked about development after mining completed. Ms White indicated that the land would be returned to agricultural land.

✤ It was moved by Director Patterson and seconded by Director Fowler that the FEL subcommittee recommends to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to negotiate and execute an Amendment to Drainage Ditch easement, subject to approval as to form by District legal counsel.

MISSOURI RIVER TRAIL – PHASE 2 – INTERLOCAL COOPERATION ACT AGREEMENT WITH DOUGLAS COUNTY: Jim Becic reported that the Nebraska Department of Roads approved a funding request for \$500,000 to assist in the construction costs of the Missouri River Trail – Phase 2. The proposed Interlocal Cooperation Act Agreement with Douglas County, which is a requirement of NDOR, would allow the District to locate portions of the trail on road rights of way. There was a brief discussion.

✤ It was moved by Director John Conley and seconded by Director Fowler that the FEL subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed Interlocal Cooperation Act Agreement between the County of Douglas, Nebraska and the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District for the Missouri River Trail Project - Phase 2, subject to amendments deemed necessary by the General Manager and approved as to form by District Legal Counsel.
