Randy Hummel gave the water use report. The water use report for December water was 157.2% with the monthly average at 95.7%. The meters for December usage were read shortly after December 25<sup>th</sup> for the month. There were 21 customers on the February 13<sup>th</sup>, Certified shut-off list. All 21 customers made payment or arrangements to make payment.

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The water use report for January water was 71.2% with the monthly average at 95.7%. There were 37 customers on the March 13<sup>th</sup>, Certified shut-off list.
