REPORT ON LEGISLATIVE HEARING (held at NRC on August 31, 2004):

General Manager, Steve Oltmans and Assistant General Manager, Marlin Petermann briefed the subcommittee on the hearing.

Marlin Petermann discussed LR 278 – Development below Non-High Hazard Dams. He briefed the subcommittee on testimony offered by the Papio-Missouri River NRD at the hearing (attached to file copy).

Steve Oltmans then briefed the subcommittee on P-MRNRD testimony on LR 404 (attached to file copy). The purpose of LR 404 is to study and review issues involved in funding storm water runoff requirements of the federal Clean Water Act. The NRD testimony also highlighted a need for the P-MRNRD to have authority to issue general obligation bonds to finance future flood control reservoir construction. Draft legislation for such authority was included in the testimony and discussed by the Subcommittee

* It was moved by Conley and seconded by Tesar that the subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to seek general obligation bonding authority for the Papio-Missouri River NRD.
